GRAPE VARIETY

91% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Petit Verdot

WINEMAKER

Nigel Kinsman. Nigel's wine journey has taken him from vineyard and cellar work across Australia, international experience at Tolaini in Tuscany, and finally to high-end winemaking in Napa at Araujo Estates and Bella Oaks.

VINEYARDS

For the 2021 Laurea, Cabernet Sauvignon from Diamond Mountain, from Terravina Vineyard overlooking Lake Hennessey, Petit Verdot from Ecotone (formerly David Abreu's Thorevilos), Cabernet Sauvignon from M-bar Ranch located in the western bench of Oakville and Yountville.

WINEMAKING

Hand-harvested and fermented in stainless steel tanks. Aged in new and used French oak barrels for 21 months before bottling. Low 600 cases and is a masterclass in balance and complexity.

TASTING NOTES

Inviting bouquet of fresh blueberries, pluots, and dark brambly undertones, a subtle hint of tobacco and delicate baking spices. The palate artfully balances earthy, terroir-driven elements with notes of dark, ripe fruit and super fine tannins. 96-point rating, Jeb Dunnuck.
