VINEYARD

Founded by William Harrison, this family-owned Rutherford estate has focused on small-production Bordeaux varieties since the early 1990s. The nine-acre estate vineyard benefits from well-drained soils, warm afternoons, and cool evenings, producing Cabernet Sauvignon with concentrated fruit, structure, and aging potential.

WINEMAKING

The outstanding 2021 Napa Valley vintage delivered low yields and intensely concentrated fruit. Small-lot fermentations and aging in French oak barrels enhanced complexity while preserving the vineyard's character. The result is a Cabernet that balances power, elegance, and long-term cellaring potential.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of **blackberry, cassis, cedar, and baking spice** lead to flavors of **black currant, plum, cocoa, and espresso**. Firm yet polished tannins frame a full-bodied palate, while balanced acidity carries through a long, elegant finish. Enjoy now with grilled steaks, braised short ribs, or cellar for 8–12 years.
